The Grape



Chardonnay is the most widely planted white grape in California. The cool climate of the Santa Cruz Mountains combined with lean mountain soil make the ideal environment for growing intense Chardonnay fruit with great aging potential.

The Land



Skyland Vineyard is a one-acre dry farmed vineyard planted in 1999 that lies within sight of Monterey Bay. Steeply terraced, it offers sandy loam mountain soils and extended periods of sunlight from full southern exposure. Sunny Acres Vineyard, a four-acre cane pruned vineyard, is nestled in a quaint valley within 3 miles of the Pacific Ocean near the town of Scotts Valley.
