The Grape



Grenache is one of the most widely planted red wine varieties in the world. It ripens late, so it needs warm day temperatures to express its true characteristic flavor profiles of strawberry and raspberry, and sour cherries. Grenache is one of six grapes allowed in red Bordeuax wines. As Rosé varietals, these grapes produce a wine with big structure, great body and acidity, and traditionally a pale salmon color.

The Land



Located on the Eastside of 101 in the Geneseo District, Pear Valley enjoys the cooling effect from the winds that arrive every day around 3 pm throughout the growing season. This cooling effect helps retain the acidity in the wines along with the complex shale rocky soils, produce wines that are rich and balanced. The Grenache vines are perfectly suited for this site.

The Season

The winter of 2019 brought a welcomed bounty of rain to many regions of California. No frost during the springtime bud break and mild weather in bloom time May, were great signs of a bumper crop to come. An overall warm year with out any major heat spikes with cooling fall weather, allowing the vineyards to ripen slowly, maximizing full flavor development. A winemakers' dream vintage!
